Membership Notes

New members joining during the year will be liable to pay one twelfth of the annual subscription fee for each full or part month remaining between their election to membership and the end of the calendar year.

Family membership is applicable to a senior couple or single parent family and one or more children living at the same address. For the purposes of family membership, children living at the same address are included up to age 21. Student discount for Juniors is not applicable for this category.

Lunchtime membership allows members to use the club house facilities, on Wednesday (Lunch and Dinner). Thursday (Lunch Only) and Friday (Lunch and Evening). Lunchtime members cannot use the club at weekends.

Applications for membership are completed on Membermojo before being considered by the Committee. In the case of application for 'Cadet Membership', one parent (or guardian) must also be a TBYC member.

Payment of Subscriptions by Instalments

Subscriptions and fees may be paid by instalments, in which case the amounts shown will be increased by 10% to cover additional administrative costs. The total amount due will be paid by 11 equal payments from February to December inclusive.

Please note that the final date for all subscription and fees to be received is <u>28th February</u>. Without exception, any payments received after this date will incur a 10% surcharge. All subscriptions by instalment must be communicated to the office by the 31st of January and should be set up for the 1st of each month from February 2025.
